2. Print out the **Get to Know Your Valley Challenge Location Log** (page 2 of this pdf) so you can log your visit. You may also want to print the map on page 3.
3. Visit as many of sites on the list of locations throughout the year. Do it in any order and at your own pace.
4. Optional: While at the site take a selfie, or just of picture of the location if you're camera shy. Best of all, take a photo of you and your horse at the location. There will be a **Special Extra Award** for best photo of location taken through horse's ears (judged by TRVEA board).
