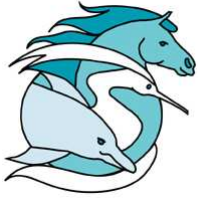


Summer 2010 Juniors' Horse Camp

June 21 through June 25 (Monday through Friday), 3PM to 6PM

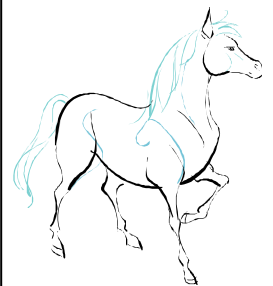
Who: Riders ages 6 through 16
