ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
TIJUANA RIVER VALLEY EQUESTRIAN ASSOCIATION\  
BORDER FIELD MOUNTED ASSISTANCE UNIT**

**I**

The name of this Corporation shall be the **Tijuana River Valley Equestrian Association\Border Field Mounted Assistance Unit**.

**II**

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.
- B. The specific and primary purpose of **Tijuana River Valley Equestrian Association\Border Field Mounted Assistance Unit** is to promote camaraderie among valley horsemen and to promote awareness and understanding of equestrian riders in the Tijuana River Valley of the need to protect and preserve its resources, and to augment regular ranger patrols at Border Field State Park and Tijuana River Valley Estuarine Sanctuary, in a voluntary capacity and under the direction of the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Frontera District, to provide information to park rangers of any illegal activities, vandalism, and trail conditions, and to maintain and preserve all public and equestrian trails.
- C. Additional purposes for which this Corporation is organized are:
  - 1. To assist park and sanctuary visitors, to provide information concerning trail conditions, directions, general park information, rules and regulations, natural history and other subjects.
  - 2. To provide emergency first aid and other assistance to park and sanctuary visitors and their horses.
  - 3. To promote a better understanding of the usefulness of horses in public service.
  - 4. To raise and solicit money and other property for its organizational purposes by public or private subscription, donation, gift, bequest, or devise.
  - 5. To engage in any other activity or to perform any other act or function, not contrary to law, which will promote or encourage the purposes of this organization, and in carrying out any of its purposes to seek the enlightenment, improvement, and other betterment of its members as well as to raise revenue.

### III

B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

- a. by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or,
- b. by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

### IV

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
