Parade practice will be held periodically to help prepare you and your horse for these events. A practice schedule for each parade will be determined once we have submitted our application for the event. Anyone can practice, but not everyone will qualify. Our parade costume typically requires a black cowboy hat, black pants, and black boots, with a variety of shirts and vests, depending on the parade theme. You will be given information on where to purchase clothing to match the parade unit once you have qualified for a parade.
